

**ORDINANCE 86-2
ZONING CITATIONS
PRICE COUNTY, WISCONSIN
Adopted, February 18, 1986**

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Price do ordain as follows:

For the purpose listed in Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.119 the Price County Board of Supervisors adopt the Citation Ordinance as follows:

SECTION I: PURPOSE

1. The Purpose of this Ordinance is to achieve greater efficiency and economy in the enforcement of certain Price County Ordinances and to guarantee the fairness and consistency of enforcement procedures.

SECTION II: AUTHORITY

1. This Ordinance is created pursuant to the authority granted by Chapter 66.119 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Price County elects to use the citation method of enforcement of certain ordinances other than those for which a statutory counterpart exists.
2. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed to prevent the use of any other method of enforcing Price County Ordinances, including but not limited to, the use of a summons and complaint under Chapters 66 and 299 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION III: ORDINANCE AFFECTED

1. Citations may be issued in the enforcement of the following ordinances:
 1. Price County Zoning Ordinance
 2. Price County Sanitary & Private Sewage Ordinance
 3. Price County Sub-division Control Ordinance
 4. Price County Nuisance Ordinance
 5. Price County Shoreland Ordinance

SECTION IV: PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE CITATIONS

1. The following persons may issue citations authorized under this Ordinance:
 1. Any Price County Law Enforcement Officer
 2. The Price County Zoning Administrator

SECTION V: THE CITATION

1. The Citations issued pursuant to this Ordinance shall provide for the following
 1. The name and address of the alleged violator.

2. The factual allegations describing the alleged violation.
3. The time and place of the offense.
4. The Section of the Ordinance violated.
5. A designation of the offense in such a manner as can readily be understood by a person making a reasonable effort to do so.
6. The time at which the alleged violator may appear in court.
7. A statement which in essence informs the alleged violator:
 1. That the alleged violator may make a cash deposit based on the schedule established by this Ordinance to be mailed or delivered to the Clerk of Courts prior to the time of the scheduled court appearance.
 2. That if the alleged violator makes such a deposit, he or she need not appear in court unless subsequently summoned.
 3. That if the alleged violator makes a cash deposit and does not appear in court, either he or she will be deemed to have tendered a plea of no contest and submitted to a forfeiture not to exceed the amount of the deposit or will be summoned into court to answer the complaint if the court does not accept the plea of no contest
 4. That if the alleged violator does not make a cash deposit and does not appear in court at the time specified, an action may be commenced against the alleged violator to collect the forfeiture.
8. A direction that if the alleged violator elects to make a cash deposit, the alleged violator shall sign an appropriated statement which accompanies the citation to indicate that he or she read the statement required under Section V,A(7) of this Ordinance and shall send the signed statement with the cash deposit.

SECTION VI: FORM OF CITATION

1. The form of the citation used under this Ordinance shall be approved by the Price County District Attorney and the Price County Zoning Committee. Such approval shall be recorded in said Committee's minutes.

SECTION VII: SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS

 2. Failure to reclaim after closure \$500
8. Junk and Salvage Yards
 1. Operation without an approved permit \$100
 2. Violation of Junk Yard Provisions as specified in the Price County Zoning Ordinance \$100
9. Sanitary Landfills \$100
10. Signs
 1. Any violation of the sign section in the Price County Zoning Ordinance that has to do with permits and characteristics to signs \$ 50
11. Subdivision Control
 1. Creation of lots without Zoning Committee approval unless exempt from platting controls as described in Sec 236.03 & 236.45(2), Wisconsin Statutes \$100/lot
12. Private Sewage Systems
 1. Installation of system or repair of same without a valid Master Plumber's license or Journeyman's under a Master's supervision
 1. Septic Tank \$275
 2. Drainfield \$275
 3. Both \$400

Note: Fine to installer and homeowner (may also be same person)
 2. Privies
 1. Without a Permit \$ 50
 2. Setback Violations \$ 50
 3. Waste Disposal Violations \$ 650
13. Public Health Nuisances
 1. Any public health nuisance declared in the Price County Nuisance Ordinance \$100

SECTION VIII: PROCEDURE

1. The Procedure provisions of Chapter 66.119 of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby

adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION IX: NONEXCLUSIVITY

1. Adoption of this Ordinance in no way precludes the adoption of any other Ordinance providing for the enforcement of any law or Ordinance relating to the same or any other matter. The issuance of a citation under this Ordinance in no way precludes preceding under any other law or Ordinance relating to the same or any other matter.
2. Submission of a deposit shall in no way alleviate the alleged violator of future citations, should the alleged offense remain uncorrected.

SECTION X: SEVERABILITY

1. Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid or be repealed, the constitutionality or validity of the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION XI: EFFECTIVE DATE

1. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by the Price County Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
