1. Public Comment and Communication: None.

It does not look like State funding will be available soon enough. Correction officer resignation. Boat patrol startup with reimbursement in 2020. Upcoming pilot class for drone operation. Motion Palecek/Hallstrand to approve the vouchers in the amount of \$157,542.49. Motion carried.
 - a. K-9 Unit: Implementation moving forward. A couple from Milwaukee will be paying for start-up expenses. Three deputies interviewed for handler position.
