Support and Housing Options

Below is a description of the options available when a person begins to consider arranging for care in the home or outside of the home.

In Home Care: People can receive services in their own home including chore services, supportive home care, home delivered meals, shopping service, home health care, personal care, transportation. Services can be provided by family and friends or provided by private agencies. Services can be funded privately or funded through a long-term care program for those that qualify. In recent years, Caregivers are relying more and more on technology to assist with monitoring and care of their loved ones.

Adult Day Care Centers: These centers offer services to adults for part of the day in a group setting. Services may include activities that meet physical, social, and activity needs, health checks, help to take medicine, meals personal care, supervision, transportation.

Senior Housing and Independent Living Apartments: This is rental housing specially designed for and marketed to elderly tenants. These apartments are designed to meet the needs of seniors.

One or two bed Adult Family Homes: This is the least restrictive type of placement that provides 24-hour care. The certifying agency can be a Managed Care Organization, County or WI Department of Health Services.

Assisted Living: The Division of Quality Assurance licenses and regulates Assisted Living Facilities in WI. An assisted living facility is a place for people who need care but not 24-hour skilled nursing care.

- 1) **Residential Care Apartment Complexes:** Independent apartment units in which the following services are provided: room and board, up to 28 hours per week of supportive care, personal care, and nursing services. This setting is not meant for people with conditions that require more in-depth care.
- 2) **Adult Family Homes:** A place where 3 or 4 adults who are not related to the operator reside and receive care, treatment or services that are above the level of room and board and that may include up to 7 hours per week of nursing care per resident.
- 3) **Community-Based Residential Facility (CBRF):** A place where 5 or more unrelated people live together in a community setting. The services provided include room and board, supervision, support services, and may include up to 3 hours of nursing care per week.

Nursing Home: A place where 5 or more persons who are not related to the operator or administrator reside, receive care or treatment and, because of their mental or physical condition, require access to 24-hour nursing services, including limited nursing care, intermediate level nursing care and skilled nursing services.

Disability Benefit Specialist

Disability Benefit Specialist are trained to assist persons age 17 ½ to 59 years old with public benefit programs including application and appeal procedures for disability. The DBS helps in other programs including, but not limited to Social Security Disability, Supplemental Security Income, Medicare, Medicaid and benefit and insurance issues. We now have a DBS housed at the Price County Branch of the ADRC!

Elder Benefit Specialist

Elder Benefit Specialists (EBS) are trained to help those 60 and over navigate the complex world of benefit programs including, but not limited to: Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid, and WI Senior Care. We are known as the "Red Tape Cutters". Request to meet with the Price County Elder Benefit Specialist by calling the ADRC Regional Line 866-663-3607, calling 715-339-2158 or visiting our local ADRC-N office.

Dementia Care Specialist

Your Dementia Care Specialist provides free consultation in the home or office, memory screens, Powerful Tools for Caregivers Training, and Dementia Friendly Business Training. The DCS also facilitates the Alzheimer's and Caregiver Support Groups and Memory Café. The DCS is a source of support to caregivers, newly diagnosed individuals and to the community. Our local Price County Dementia Care Specialist covers both Price and Iron Counties.

Tribal Aging and Disability Resource Specialists (Tribal ADRS)

ABUSE-ELDER/ ABUSE-DOMESTIC

What is Abuse?

An adult at risk is any adult who has a physical or mental condition that impairs the ability to care for their needs and who has experienced, is experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing abuse, neglect, self-neglect, or financial exploitation. An elder adult at risk is any person age 60 or older who has experienced, is experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing abuse, neglect, self-neglect, or financial exploitation.

Abuse-per Wis. Stat. §46.90(1) can mean any of the following:

Physical abuse is intentional or reckless infliction of physical pain or injury, illness, or any impairment of physical condition.

Emotional abuse is language or behavior that serves no legitimate purpose and is intended to intimidate, humiliate, threaten, frighten, or otherwise harass the individual to whom the conduct or language is directed.

Sexual abuse is sexual contact or intercourse with another person

without consent (a violation of criminal assault law).

Treatment without Consent – the administration of medication or the performance of psychosurgery, electro-convulsive therapy, or experimental research on an individual who has not provided informed consent, with the knowledge that no lawful authority exists for the administration or performance.

Unreasonable Confinement or Restraint – the intentional and unnecessary confinement of an individual in a locked room, involuntary separation from his or her living area, use of physical restraints, or the provision of unnecessary or excessive medication.

Financial Exploitation – as defined in Wis. Stat. §46.90(1)(ed), means any of the following:

Theft-act of taking another persons property or services without that persons permission or consent with the intent to deprive the rightful owner of it. Obtaining an individual's money or property by deceiving or enticing the individual.

Forcing, compelling, or coercing an individual to give, sell at less than fair market value, or in other ways transfer money or property against their will without informed consent. The substantial failure or neglect of a fiscal agent to fulfill his or her responsibilities.

Unauthorized use of an individual's personal identifying information or documents.

Unauthorized use of an entity's identifying information or documents. Forgery & Financial transaction card crimes.

Neglect – the failure of a caregiver, as evidenced by an act, omission, or course of conduct, to endeavor to secure or maintain adequate care, services, or supervision for an individual, including food, clothing, shelter, or physical or mental health care, and creating significant risk or danger to the individual's physical or mental health.

"Neglect" does not include a decision that is made to not seek medical care for an individual, if that decision is consistent with the

individual's previously executed declaration or do-not-resuscitate order under Chapter 154, a power of attorney for health care under Chapter 155, or as otherwise authorized by law.

Self-Neglect – a significant danger to an individual's physical or mental health because the individual is responsible for his or her own care but fails to obtain adequate care, including food, shelter, clothing, or medical or dental care.

GUARDIAN AND REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE SERVICES

Guardian means a person or
agency appointed by a court to act

for an adult who has been found
to have a functional impairment in
decision-making or communication
that meets the legal standard for a
finding of incompetence. No person
in Wisconsin is a guardian for an
adult unless appointed by a court,
and no guardian has any powers
over an adult except those given by
statutes and the court order. There
are two kinds of guardian, Guardian
of Person, and Guardian of Estate.
Representative Payee means a
person who acts as the receiver of
United States Social Security
Disability or Supplemental Security
Income for a person who is not fully
capable of managing their own
benefits, i.e. cannot be their own payee.

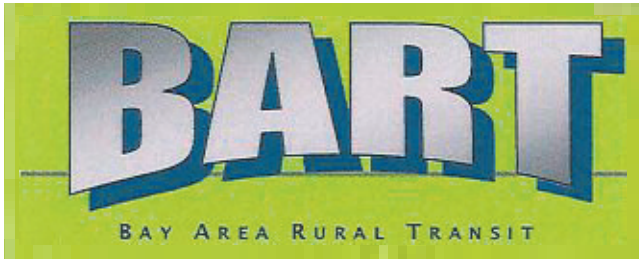

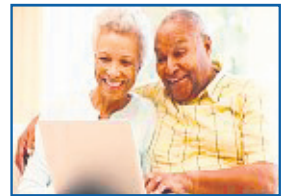

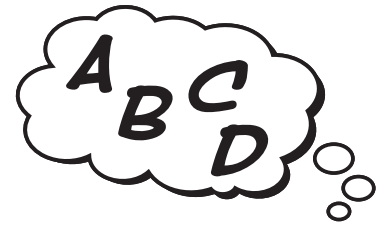

PRICE COUNTY ELDERLY AND DISABLED TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

NEED SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU?

Transportation using a Volunteer Driver is available to the following:

Self Pay/Elderly or Disabled Consumers

This service is available to persons age 60 or older, or disabled individuals of any age. Consumers will be allowed up to three scheduled trips per week, provided a driver is available and other sources of transportation such as family and friends are not available. Priority is given to those requesting rides to medical appointments or to work. Other types of trips may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

The fee for this service is \$0.35 per mile, round-trip, or a \$4.00 minimum trip charge.

Medical Assistance Consumers

Transportation to medical appointments is provided to Medical Assistance recipients through the state-wide non-emergency transportation manager, MTM. To access this service, call MTM at 1-8666-907-1493. If you are enrolled in Family Care, contact your case manager.

NEED NON-MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION? SHOPPING/ERRAND SERVICE:

This service is provided to consumers age 60 or older, or disabled individuals of any age to shop and do errands (example: grocery store, bank, laundry, lawyer/business affairs, etc.) in their own local areas. The fee for this service is \$4.00.

If you live within a 5 mile radius of downtown Park Falls or downtown Phillips, the BART Bus is available for your transportation needs at 1-844-682-9664. If you live outside of this area and need to shop or do errands, please call 715-339-5240 for additional information.



Assisted Shopping Service

If you cannot shop independently, our volunteer drivers can assist you in the store or even do your shopping for you while you remain in the comforts of home. The fee for assisted shopping is \$10.00.

ARE YOU A VETERAN?

Transportation for Veterans originates at the Price County Veteran's Service Office. If you are a Veteran, contact the CVSO at 715-339-2545 to find out if you qualify. Veterans will be allowed up to three scheduled trips per week provided a driver is available and other sources of transportation such as family and friends are not available. Fees are based on the Price County Veteran's Service Office rules and regulations.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- Call 715-339-5240 to make arrangements for transportation. Leave a message with your name and phone number as well as the date, time and place of your appointment.
- Call at least two business days before your scheduled appointment whenever possible.
- You and your doctor or medical provider will need to sign a slip to verify your medical appointment.
